Here are some great tips to get your child excited about reading and learning this summer:

- Invite your child to point out and read familiar words in a book you are sharing.
- Read and compare two books by the same author or on the same subject.
- Ask questions after reading: Where and when does the story take place? Who are the main characters? What do they do? Why and how do they do it?
- As you read aloud together, pause to look up any unfamiliar words.
- Speak with your school or local librarian about recommended books and upcoming book events that your child might enjoy.
